

Five Element Acupuncture Principles and Clinical Application.

This two-day seminar is ideally designed for practitioners who have some familiarity with the concept of the integration of body, mind, spirit which forms the basis of Five Element acupuncture, and is an integral part of diagnosis and treatment, honoring the unique individuality of each patient. Included in the workshop is a basic review of the five elemental phases, the Officials of the realm, and we will discuss the historical context of acupuncture from the point of view of the progression of both TCM and Five Element acupuncture since the '70's. Practitioners will learn to work with the patient's constitutional strength/weakness as a basis for understanding the cause and evolution of symptoms/syndromes, and to apply the basic concepts of Five Element acupuncture in clinical practice including exploring its basis as presented in the Chinese medical classics.

Day one will focus on exploring the five elements both in nature and in Five Element theory and their relationships according to sheng and k'e cycles and the expanded role of the zang/fu in Five Element Acupuncture. Basic laws of nature, the concept of causative factor (constitutional strength/weakness), based on observation.

Day two will include interactive diagnostic practicum (including identification of color, sound, odor and emotion exercises), Five element pulse diagnosis with feedback and provide an opportunity for questions, both clinical and theoretical.
